Bible Story Intro:

Super-friends, I loved seeing your big strong muscles when we practiced our memory verse. I have a question for you and I want you to think about your answer in your head but don't say it out loud until I tell you. Who is your favorite super hero? Everybody know what their answer is going to be? (Pause.) Great, now using your normal talking voice, on 3, everyone say your favorite super hero. 1, 2, 3 Go. (Pause.) Oh, I hear (List the superheroes you hear children mention.) Those are some awesome superheroes. Superheroes have to be really, really brave to help people. Today we're going to hear about someone in the Bible who had a big, scary job to do and she needed God to help her be brave enough to do it. Let's watch to find out more.

Bible Story Recap

Esther had a big, scary job to do to ask the king to protect God's people. She was really scared and asked God's people to help her be brave. What did she ask God's people to do to help her? (Pause.) That's right! She asked them to pray! And God helped her be brave enough to ask the king for help. And the king helped and God's people were saved! We can pray and ask God to help us be brave, too!

*Friends, let me ask you that important question one more time – **Who can help you be brave? God can help me be brave!** Let's say it again! **Who can help you be brave? God can help me be brave!***

Sample Prayer:

"Dear God,

Please help us be brave like you helped Esther. Thank you for always being with us. We love you, God. In Jesus' name, Amen.

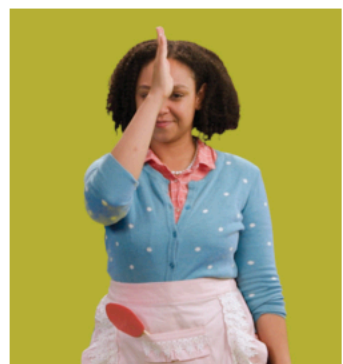
