SLIDE: Theme

Hi, everyone! I'm so happy to be with you today. It's the final week of our series 'Like and Subscribe: Share the Love of Jesus!'

This series is called 'Like and Subscribe,' because when you see something awesome online, you like it and subscribe to it because you don't want to miss a minute of awesomeness. And you want to share that awesomeness with your friends and family too!

This month we're talking about the love of God! That's definitely not something you want to miss a second of! And you so want to share it! Before we go any farther—let's get started with a question. I'm going to give you some time to discuss this question as a group....

When have you shown love to others? (*walk around and listen to kids' answer in their groups. Bring them back together in a few minutes when most groups are done*). *If time, have a couple of kids share their answers with the group.*

While Jesus showed love to every single person, He showed extra care and compassion for those who were sick and hurting ... the people who needed Him most! This week, we're going to look at how Jesus stopped what He was doing—and what the Savior is doing is always important—to help some people who were in need. Jesus is so loving and kind and good.

But before we get into our true story from the Bible, let me tell you about something awesome we're doing this year! We're going through the Bible cover-to-cover!

Why? Well, God gave us the Bible so we can get to know Him. So as we go through the stories of the Bible, we'll learn about God!

We're going to go through God's Big Story in the Bible together so we can learn about God! (*Gesture to slide.*)

SLIDE: God's Big Story

We're at the part of the Bible where Jesus was on earth, teaching us about God. Let's see what happened when Jesus encountered two people who really needed His help.

The girl had not only been raised to life again, but she was completely well! No matter how important Jesus' plans were, He always had time to stop and show God's love by helping someone in need. Like our bottom line says for today.

SLIDE: Bottom Line

Jesus shows love to people in need.

Jesus was on the most important mission ever: to give up His life to save the whole world, so we can be close to God! But that didn't stop Jesus from pausing in His day to show God's love to specific people who needed His help.

And *all* of us need His help. Whether you're really sick and need healing or a little sad and need encouragement, Jesus is with you, and He will help you through it. You can choose to be still and breathe and ask Jesus to show you His love. And when you've spent time with Jesus and experienced His love, you can pass it on to the people around you who are in need.

One of the best ways to show love like Jesus is to be willing to stop what you're doing to offer help—like if you're in the middle of a new level in your video game, but your little sister wants you to help her fix her block build. Or maybe you're at lunch, laughing with your friends, and you see a kid who's all alone, so you invite them over.

Don't forget: you can also pay attention to how Jesus shows love to *you* through other people who help meet your needs. Because the more you see the love of Jesus in action, the more you'll be able to share it with others in need.

Let's talk to the God who loves you so much!

Dear God, thank You for showing Your love for us by sending Jesus. Thank You that Jesus always had time to help people in need. Remind us throughout the week of ways that we can show the love of Jesus to people around us who are in need. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."
