Bible Story Recap

Oh no. I think I might be worried about the wrong thing. Instead of rushing to get everything done like Martha did, I should slow down and focus on what really matters: Jesus. Let's all take a deep breath. (Pause.) Martha wanted to work hard to make sure that she could do good things for Jesus, but Jesus said that it's more important to spend time WITH Jesus, like Mary did. Jesus loves us so much he wants to spend time with us. Jesus wants us to listen to all the things he has to say and he wants to hear what we have to say when we pray!

*Friends, let me ask you that important question one more time – **Who loves you? Jesus loves me!** Let's say it again! **Who loves you? Jesus loves me!***

Sample Prayer:

*“Dear God,
Thank you for loving us so much you gave us Jesus.
Help us remember to slow down and spend time with you, just like Mary.
We love you, God. In Jesus' name, Amen.*
