Bible Story Intro:

Friends, in our Bible verse this month, Jesus says to let the children come to me. If you saw Jesus, what would you do? Would you give him a hug, or maybe a fist bump? What would you do? (Pause for answers.) Nice! Jesus loves you so much and would be so excited to see you! Today in our true Bible Story, we’re going to hear about some kids who wanted to see Jesus and see what Jesus did when he saw them. Let’s watch to find out.

Bible Story Recap

The kids wanted to see Jesus, but the disciples tried to stop them. They said that Jesus was too busy for the kids and they wanted them to go away. But did Jesus agree with the disciples? (Pause.) No! He said to let the little children come to him because Jesus loved them so much. Jesus said that they are God’s children and that they are important to God and important to Jesus. You are God’s child, too, and He will never stop loving you, no matter what! Jesus is never too busy for you and Jesus wants to be your friend forever!

*Friends, let me ask you that important question one more time – **Who loves you? Jesus loves me!** Let’s say it again! **Who loves you? Jesus loves me!***

Sample Prayer:

Thank you for never being too busy for us.
Thank you for loving us so much you gave us Jesus.
We love you, God. In Jesus’ name, Amen.*
