## Large Group Prompts

### Countdown/Worship Song #1: Love Like Jesus

#### **Key Question/Bottom Line:**

*Who loves you?  
Jesus loves me!*

#### **Monthly Bible Verse:**

*“Jesus said, ‘Let the children come to me.’” Matthew 19:14*

#### **Bible Story Intro:**

*Friends, all month long we have been learning that Jesus loves us so much! We learned that Jesus loves children and want to be with us. We learned that Jesus loves us so much that he always wants to be with us, even when we aren't listening or aren't following him. We learned that Jesus says it's more important to be with Jesus than to do things for him. Jesus loves us always, no matter what. Is there anything we could do that would make Jesus stop loving us? (Pause.) What if we messed up and did something we really shouldn't do? (Pause.) Today in our true Bible Story, we're going to hear about a woman who made some bad choices and we will see what Jesus says to her.*

### Ollie Video: Jesus Forgives a Woman

#### **Bible Story Recap**

*The woman made a bad choice and did something she knew was wrong. People brought her to Jesus because they wanted to punish her. They weren't telling her that God loves her or trying to help her, they just wanted her to be in trouble. But Jesus reminded them that we all mess up, but God still loves us, no matter what! Jesus forgave her and showed her that he loves her, no matter what. There is nothing we can do that could make Jesus stop loving us.*

*Friends, let me ask you that important question one more time – **Who loves you? Jesus loves me!** Let's say it again! **Who loves you? Jesus loves me!***

#### **Sample Prayer:**

*“Dear God,  
Thank you for loving us so much that you forgive us when we mess up.  
Your love never stops.  
We love you, God. In Jesus' name, Amen.*
