Key Question/Bottom Line:

Monthly Bible Verse:

Bible Story Intro:

Friends, I’m so glad you’re all here today! I would miss you so much if you weren’t here. Today in our true Bible Story, we’re going to hear about something that was missing. Have you ever lost something? Maybe you lost your favorite toy or you couldn’t find the shoes you really wanted to wear. How did you feel when you couldn’t find what you were looking for? (Pause.) I heard sad, or mad, or frustrated. Raise your hand if you would just give up and find something else to play with or wear. (Pause.) Today we’re going to hear a story that Jesus told about a shepherd who lost something very important. Let’s watch to see what he does.

Bible Story Recap

What was the shepherd missing? (Pause.) A sheep! Oh no! Did he just say “That’s okay, I have a bunch more sheep, I don’t need to worry about that one.”? (Pause.) No! The Shepherd loved the sheep so much that he left all the others to go and find his missing sheep. That’s how Jesus sees us, too! Jesus loves us and wants to be with us, so no matter where we are or what we’re feeling, Jesus sees us and wants to be close to us!

*Friends, let me ask you that important question one more time – **Who loves you? Jesus loves me!** Let’s say it again! **Who loves you? Jesus loves me!***
