Bible Story Intro:

Friends, I'm so glad you're here today! This month we're going to be learning about some of the amazing things that Jesus did and I'm excited for you to learn all about it. Before we jump into our Bible Story with Ollie today, I want to let you guys know, it's going to look a little different. Raise your hand if you remember that Ollie looked different last month. (Pause.) Well today, it's going to change even more. We're going to have a new song and we're going to meet some new friends – even some new animal friends! It's going to be different, but we're still going to learn true stories from the Bible that will teach us about the amazing things Jesus did. Let's watch to learn about something amazing Jesus did!

Ollie Video: Water to Wine

Bible Story Recap

Jesus was at a wedding party when they had a big problem – they were out of the special drink! Jesus did something amazing that only he can do. He had people fill up 6 jars with water. Let's count to 6. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Great job! They put water into the jars, but then Jesus did something amazing – he turned the water into wine! Jesus can do amazing things. No one else can do what Jesus did and nothing is too hard for Jesus. Jesus can help us do hard things, too!

*Friends, let me ask you that important question one more time – **Who is amazing? Jesus is amazing!** Let's say it again! **Who is amazing? Jesus is amazing!***


