### Countdown/Worship Song #1: Everyone Everywhere

#### **Key Question/Bottom Line:**

#### **Monthly Bible Verse:**

#### **Bible Story Intro:**

When we make a mistake or a bad choice or we hurt someone. Do you think Jesus still cares about us then? (Pause.) Of course he does! Zacchaeus had made some bad choices and people didn't like Zacchaeus, but Jesus cared about him because Jesus cares about everyone! Let's watch to find out what happened.*

#### **Bible Story Recap**

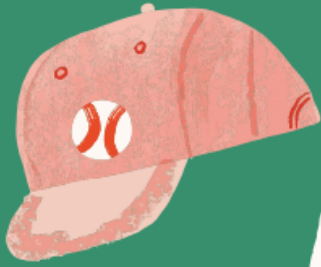
